Application:

Hydroalcoholic gel for external use, intended for rapid disinfection of hands.

Use on clean, dry hands. Does not require rinsing or drying of hands. Non-irritating by contact with the skin. Recommended in the medical field (hospitals, medical establishments, dental care centers, infirmaries of schools, kindergartens and nurseries) or the veterinary field (veterinary practice and clinic).

Effective on enveloped viruses such as Coronavirus and its variants, H1N1 etc.

TECHNICAL DATA:

Appearance: Clear colorless gel

Odor: Alcohol

pH: 6 +/- 0.5

Viscosity 20°C: 1500+/-200cPo

Directions for use:

Hygienic friction: 3mL in the hand and rub until total evaporation (minimum 30 seconds).

Surgical friction: 2x3mL in 2x30 seconds, i.e. 3 mL (refer to the packaging on page 2) in the hand and rub until total evaporation (minimum 30 seconds).

Then repeat the operation.

Step 1: Palm to palm.

Step 2 : Palm of the right hand on the back of the left hand and palm of the left hand on the back of the right hand.

Step 3: Palm to palm with fingers interlocked.

Step 4: Back of fingers against the opposite palm with fingers interlocked.

Step 5: Rotational friction of the thumb embedded in the left palm and vice versa.

Step 6: Rotational friction moving back and forth with the fingers joints of the right hand into the left palm and vice versa.

At the end of step 6, repeat the succession of the same steps appropriately until the specified washing time is completed.
